

INTERNSHIP APPLICATIONS

APPLICATION DEADLINE – THURSDAY NOVEMBER 3, 2016

ELIGIBILITY

- U.S. Citizenship
- Minimum 400 intervention hours plus 100 assessment practicum hours
- Doctoral student in good standing at an American Psychological Association (APA) or Canadian Psychological Association (CPA) accredited graduate program in Clinical, Counseling, or Combined psychology or Psychological Clinical Science Accreditation System (PCSAS) accredited program in Clinical Science. Persons with a doctorate in another area of psychology who meet the APA or CPA criteria for respecialization training in Clinical, Counseling, or Combined Psychology are also eligible.
- Approved for internship status by graduate program training director.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. AAPI ONLINE APPLICATION (available at APPIC Web Site: <http://www.appic.org/>)
2. 3-4 LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

We are primarily concerned with your clinical skills and abilities. We recommend that you submit only 1 letter from a professor who knows you only from your course work or research. The remaining letters should come from clinical supervisors. If you cannot provide a letter from a clinical site in which you completed 350+ practicum hours, please include an explanation within your cover letter.

3. COVER LETTER

Please be sure to note the following in your cover letter:

- Whether you are applying to one of our two specialty tracks
- The rotations of particular interest to you

4. PERSONAL INTERVIEW BY INVITATION

Interviews will be scheduled in January, and are expected to be in person. If an applicant is unable to make it to our site due to uncontrollable circumstances (e.g., a cancelled flight), a phone interview may be substituted. Notifications for January interviews will be emailed by December 16, 2016.
