Thank you for your interest in postdoctoral training in Clinical Psychology at Edward Hines, Jr. VA Hospital. **We are recruiting five Fellows for the 2016-2017 training year.**

Our post-doctoral fellowship program offers five emphasis areas within the umbrella of Clinical Psychology. These emphasis areas include:

- Integrated Care Psychology – 2 Fellowship Positions
- LGBT Health Care – 1 Fellowship Position
- Medical Rehabilitation Psychology – 1 Fellowship Position
- Neuropsychology – 1 Fellowship Position
- Trauma and Posttraumatic Stress Disorder – 1 Fellowship Position

All fellowship positions are for one year, with the exception of our neuropsychology emphasis position, which is a two year fellowship.

The Postdoctoral Fellowship Program at Hines VA first began in 2008. In 2012 The Commission on Accreditation completed its Site Visit for the purpose of initial accreditation by APA. Following this site visit our Fellowship Program was awarded 7 years of full APA-Accreditation. Our next site visit will be in late 2019.

The online brochure is available through a link on our webpage and should provide you with comprehensive information about our program. **Our application deadline is January 4, 2016.** Except under very unusual circumstances, all application materials must be submitted through APPA CAS.
