INTERNSHIP INTERVIEWS

JANUARY - 2013

Only those applicants showing the best fit for our program will be invited to interview with us.

Two interviews, each 30 minutes in length, will be conducted by two Psychology Training Committee members. Interviewees will also be scheduled for a 30-minute individual interview with the Training Director, and a 90-minute meeting and lunch with the current interns. 45-minute applicant group meetings with the Training Director will also be scheduled.

The individual interviews/meetings will be scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m.

An optional tour of the hospital will be provided after the interviews/meetings.

Applicants are very strongly encouraged to arrange, in advance, meetings with staff members who work in areas of interest to them. Those applicants preferring to meet with particular staff members during or following the tour hour or prior to the interviews/meetings should email (bernie.sladen@va.gov) or phone [(708) 202-2444] the Training Director in advance. Such meetings will be scheduled if the requested staff member(s) is/are available. Applicants may also email staff members directly to schedule meetings with them. However, to facilitate coordination, applicants may prefer to ask the Training Director to schedule meetings with staff, especially when applicants would like to meet with more than one staff member.

We have found this format to be highly efficient in providing the kind of information that both the interviewers and applicants need in their decision making process.
